


- ↑ | **Façade**, gallery at dusk

## **Quay Apartments**

## Zierikzee

This project joins the existing neighborhood of Poortambacht to the city's historic center. As a reaction to the specific character of the site and as a response to the modern diverging lifestyle, the design for this new quay, parallel to a canal, can be seen as a reinterpretation of the quay typologies that can be found throughout the provinces of Zeeland and Holland. As colored warehouses clad in metal, the apartment buildings stand out in comparison to the adjacent houses. Both apartment buildings, one at the west end and one in the middle of the Poortkade, interrupt the line of houses. Because of their large size they announce the presence of the urban area behind the apartment blocks.





